

## SIX-WEEK SUMMER INTENSIVE 2019

The Summer Acting Intensive is a six-week program modeled after the full-time Two Year Certificate Professional Actor Training Conservatory. The acting faculty were trained to teach by Mr. Meisner himself, making the Meisner training practiced here closest to the original source and the intention of the technique. The curriculum includes acting, voice and speech, acting for camera, voiceover, physical theatre and dance. The summer program attracts an eclectic group of artists from around the USA and the world seeking serious and disciplined experience. Classes are held Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm, 30+ hours per week approximately | 6 weeks.
